



Make Your Own Long Line And Create Safety

Long Line Recommendations

NOTE: please make and use long line at your own risk. Check the knots on a regular basis. Please use gloves when rope burn is a risk.

Long Line Assembly

1. Tie snap on with bowline knot
 2. Place stopper knots along the long line at 5-8 foot increments
- See below for recommended materials and knots.

Long Line in use

Shown below: 40 ft long line with stopper knots placed at 8 foot increments



Recommended Rope: Accessory cord

Advantages of accessory cord:

- It is light weight, strong and easier on the hands.
- It is much less prone to tangling or knotting onto itself.
- It does not gather dirt or debris.
- It does not absorb water
- Does not become heavy when wet.

Accessory cord rope is available at outdoor sports retailers that carry mountain climbing gear

Suggested rope for size of dog:

- Small dogs: 4mm accessory cord
- Medium dogs: 6mm accessory cord
- Large dogs: 8mm accessory cord



Recommended Snap: Swivel eye bolt snap

Available at hardware stores or tack/farm supply stores

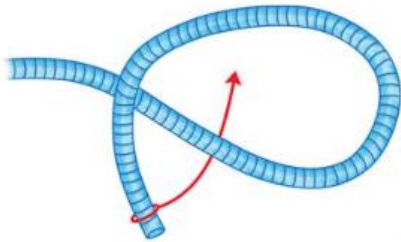


Recommended Knots

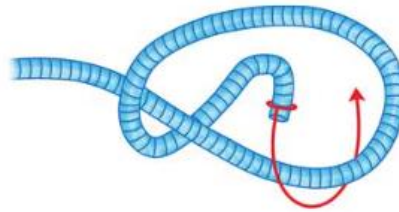
Stopper Knot - For end and grab holds



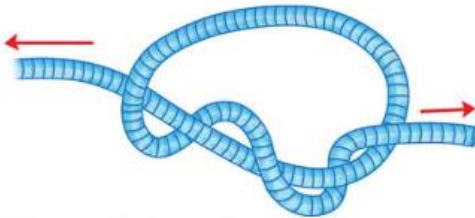
Double Overhand Knot Instructions



1 Make a loop and feed the end into it



2 Take it outside the loop and pass it through once more



3 Pull both ends to tighten



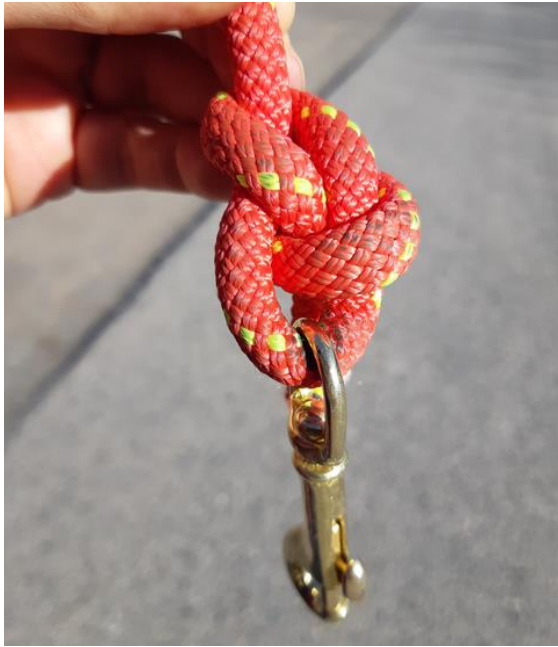
4 The two turns come close together

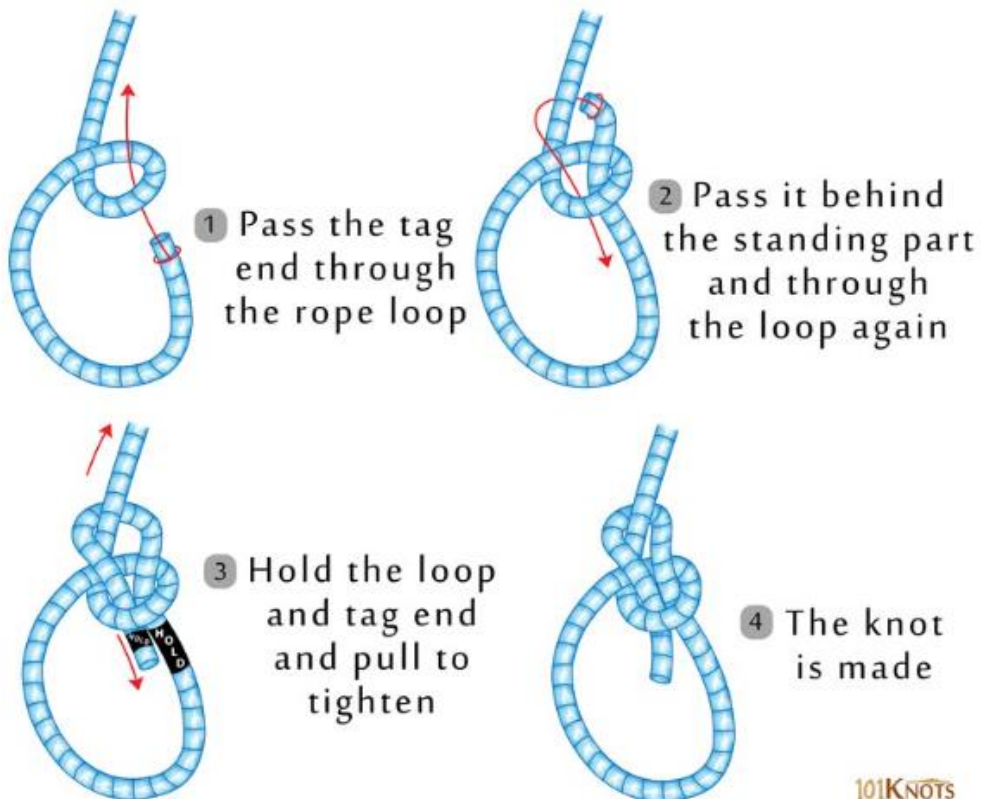
